- Systematic Reviews & Meta-Analysis
 - Support for team-based projects that meet all requirements
- Scoping Reviews
 - Support for team-based projects that meet all requirements
- Literature Reviews
 - Liaison Librarians May Help Students in search strategies
- All Other Reviews
 - No support Services

Brief History of UPC Review & Evidence Synthesis Services

- Decision to add this service to UPC programs July 1, 2020
 - Explosion in Non-Medical Sciences Systematic Review (NMSSR) publications
 - Increased interest from non-medical Faculty and Graduate Students
 - Proactive Professional Development
 - First learning traditional review & evidence synthesis (medical RCTs)
 - Learning NMSSR & Evidence Synthesis
 - Awarded Scholarship for Social Science Evidence Synthesis Institute



Brief History of UPC Review & Evidence Synthesis Services

- Developed Research Guide with Service Offering & Best Practices
- Opened Service for Teams
- Obtained all Needed Software
- Refined Services
- Presented to Association of College and Research Libraries
- Published First Reviews that were Completed
- Published Concept Papers
- Invited panelist at American Library Association Annual Conference 2023



Brief History of UPC Review & Evidence Synthesis Services

- Paired with Faculty to offer Instruction of Reviews and Evidence Synthesis
- Developed Instructional Programs for NMSSR & ES
 - One Shot Course Integrated Instructional Session
 - In Depth Course Integrated Instruction (tailored to course learning outcomes)
 - Can be Doing a Mini SR or Any Piece
 - Can be Software Training



Requirements for USC Libraries Collaboration on Systematic or Scoping Reviews

- Must be a team of three or more (Librarian will be an additional team member)
- Team must include a faculty member other than librarian faculty
- Graduate student lead teams will be considered- but this can not be part of a dissertation
- Librarian becomes a full team member and must have co-authorship on publication
- Type of review must meet our criteria for collaboration
- Best practices (as directed by faculty librarian must be followed)
- Faculty Librarian serves as Review and Information Science expert



Process of Reviews & ES at UPC

+Intake Meeting

- Research Question(s)
- Registration(s) OSF or JBI (unless publishing in SR database)
- Housekeeping (shared drive)
- Document Development (RQ, Justification, Team Composition/Contact)
- Schedule Weekly Meetings (will be used as needed)
- Discuss RQ refinement if needed

✦Inclusion and Exclusion variable discussion



Process of Reviews & ES at UPC +First Meeting

- ✦Finalize Research Question
- ✦Develop Inclusion & Exclusion Variables
- ✦Brainstorming Search Terms Document (shared drive)
- ✦Database Thesaurus Explore
- +Systematic Search Tracking Sheet Introduction (shared drive)
- ✦Zotero Description/Training
- ✦Database Discussion and Form Access (shared drive)

Process of Reviews & ES at UPC

+Second Meeting

+Strategic Systematic Search (SSS)

+SSS Tracking Sheet

+Zotero Training: Bibliographic software

+SSS Plan (downloading)



Services Faculty Librarian Provides

- Review type decision confirmation or consultation (based on research question and goals)
- Development of research question (s) (if needed)
- Facilitates development of inclusion/exclusion variables
- Administration of project (participation level varies)

- Software selection consultation and administration (participation level varies)
- Meetings/housekeeping/agendas with deliverables
- Identifies Databases
- Development of Search Terminology
 - Facilitates searching (group searching or division of search tasks)

Services Faculty Librarian Provides

- Identifies and consults on review registration
- Preliminary discovery on similar systematic reviews
- Develops/consults on review protocol
- Facilitates searching
- Training on software
- Participates in screening when appropriate

- Writes methods section of paper
- Contributes to writing other sections as need
- Tracks and/or provides tracking forms (reproducibility)
- Provides supplemental materials and charts for publication
- Identifies potential publishing opportunities
- Editorial review (if needed)
